

Life insurance coverage changes when you turn 65

If you are approaching your 65<sup>th</sup> birthday and paying for life insurance with The Hartford, the following information is intended for you.

If you are retired, your pension check shows deductions for Code 40610, 40640, 40620 or 40650. If you are active, your pay stub shows deductions for Code 40650 or 40652.

According to the terms of The Hartford's life insurance plan, your benefits and premiums will be cut by 50 percent when you reach age 65.

However, the benefits are not reduced for your spouse or dependents.

To make the change in your deduction, please fill out and return the accompanying form to Benefits Coordinator Katie Fuquay Murphy at the DPOA office at least 30 days prior to your 65<sup>th</sup> birthday.
